ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS TO BE CONSIDERED FOR THIS POSITION

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

1. Not currently “Flagged from Favorable Personnel Actions” or under a “Bar to Reenlistment.”
2. Must be or be able to complete **25S** MOSQ within 12 months of assignment.
3. Must be able to meet the required service obligation (minimum of 12 months from course completion).
4. A Soldier who has a remaining contractual service obligation due to an incentive contract for a specific MOS or UIC may apply for non-standard vacancies but will lose remaining incentive payments with the possibility of recoupment, as applicable.
5. Soldiers command removed or self-removed from promotion consideration are not eligible to apply.

MOS SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS:

1. A physical demand rating of Moderate (Gold).
2. PULHES: 212221.
3. A minimum score of 107 in aptitude area EL.
4. A minimum OPAT score of Long Jump (LJ) - 0120 cm, seated Power Throw (PT) - 0350 cm, Strength Deadlift (SD) - 0120 lbs., and Interval Aerobic Run (IR) - 0036 shuttles in Physical Demand Category of “Moderate” (Gold).
5. Normal color vision
6. A Security eligibility of SECRET is required for the initial award and to maintain the MOS.
7. A U.S. citizen.
8. Formal training (completion of the MOS 25S Course conducted under the auspices of the USA Signal School) mandatory. Waiver may be granted by Commandant, U.S. Army Signal School, ATTN: ATSO-CD, Ft Eisenhower, GA 30905-5300.
9. Be eligible for SECRET security access under provisions of AR 380-67.
10. High school graduate or equivalent.

3. Phase 3: 2 Weeks Resident Training Course

SUMMARY OF DUTIES:

The satellite communication systems operator-maintainer supervises, installs, operates, and maintains tactical through strategic multichannel satellite communications ground terminals, systems, networks, and associated equipment. Supervises, installs, operates, and maintains strategic earth terminal complexes to include associated antennas, ground terminals, technical control facilities, multiplexing and COMSEC equipment. Performs engineering quality control and continuity testing of circuits, trunks, links, systems, and facilities. Operates and performs preventive maintenance checks and services (PMCS) on assigned communications equipment, vehicles, and power generators.

1. Supervises operations and assists team members in the installation and operation of tactical and strategic telecommunication systems and networks, including satellite communication systems and technical control facilities. Supervises, performs, and assists team members in the performance of field unit level maintenance on assigned communications equipment. Requests logistical support. Prepares input for statistical and other operational reports. Identifies and reports electronic jamming and deception and applies appropriate Electronic Counter Countermeasures (ECCM).
